ADMINISTRATION FOOT NOTES:

1. Candidates must bring (2) sets of ACU/OCP - Coat/Trousers/Patrol Cap complete with Rank/Insignia. **Rank will not be worn while in SFAS. This is in addition to the uniforms that are required above
2. T-Shirts must be loose fitting cotton, NO TIGHT FITTING, Under Armour or other athletic shirts are not authorized
3. Unauthorized items will be confiscated and placed in hold baggage during initial layout. If items are found during subsequent inspections, that item will be confiscated and student will be released from course.
4. The only electronic item authorized upon arrival to SFAS is the Service Members Cellular Phone
NO OTHER ELECTRONICS ARE AUTHORIZED
5. This packing list provides guidance for winter and summer classes.
6. Winter items are mandatory for October 15 - April 15 selection courses.
7. Uniforms must have engineer tape sewn as per SFAS Standard Operating Procedures. An example can be referenced on the SFAS Milsuite site listed at the top of the packing list

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE UNAUTHORIZED AND ARE GROUNDS FOR RELIEF FROM THE COURSE

1. CELLULAR PHONES (THESE WILL BE TURNED IN AND LOCKED UP DURING THE INITIAL LAYOUT)
2. ANY PRODUCT CONTAINING CAFFEINE
3. TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY TYPE
4. CIVILIAN LONG UNDERWEAR
5. CONTACT LENSES
6. MODIFIED SHOULDER STRAPS, OR KIDNEY PADS
7. SPANDEX, ATHLETIC WEAR/UNDERWEAR (i.e. TIGHT FITTING UNDERARMOR)
8. SUPPLEMENTS, VITAMINS, ENERGY PRODUCTS OF ANY TYPE
9. GORTEX SOCKS
10. CIVILIAN MEDICATIONS (I.E. ASPIRIN, TYLENOL)
11. NO PERSONAL TA 50
12. NO KINESIOLOGY OR KT TAPE
13. ELECTRONIC ITEMS - I.E. IPADS, TABLETS, LAPTOPS, SMART WATCHES, KINDLES, ANY ELECTRONIC ITEM OTHER THAN A CELLULAR PHONE
